Facts of this Matter:

- 1. Travel Destination: Indiana University, Bloomington. February 28th-March 2nd, 2025. We plan to leave at the beginning of 4th period at 11:24 am on the 28th of February and would be home by 5 pm on the 2nd of March.
- 2. Who is attending: We will take 28 students and two chaperones to this event. The students involved would be 9th to 12th grade students from the High School who are members of the Model United Nations Club.
- 3. Synopsis: The Model United Nations club would like to attend the Indiana University Model UN conference in Feb/March. The event has students participate in a high-level debate with students from around the area on current world issues. This competition highlights several important skills such as public speaking, research, and conflict resolution.

Cost to Students/Families	For this conference, the students will be paying all expenses themselves. The estimated cost of delegate, school fees and hotel will be around 250 dollars per student. We are still waiting on information from the IU Model UN about rooming costs.
About Supervision	Mr. Magoni and Mrs. Boutilier are going to the conference. We keep the ratio of 15 students to 1 chaperone. We also have had parents interested in attending our conferences and would reach out for a parent volunteer. At that point, we would do a background check through school services.

Objective POSITIVES related to this item or approach:

As a teaching method, the model UN has been proven-effective. Students role-play various countries in the world. They learn about the history, politics, and foreign policies of several countries and begin to understand the importance of the United Nations in the world today. Students become familiar with several international problems or issues and experience the give and take of diplomacy as they attempt to pass resolutions in their councils. The model provides an opportunity for them to improve their public speaking and debate skills and to learn some parliamentary procedure. They will begin to learn the skills of how to work constructively in a group when members of the group disagree on how to achieve a particular goal. The experience is a win-win situation for students

Objective NEGATIVES related to this item or approach:

The conference as a whole is a great learning experience. The only negatives are that the students will miss a half of a day at school and the cost of the trip may prohibit some students from participating in this specific event.

Financial Implications, if any:

Students would be responsible for delegate fees and hotel costs. ZCS will incur the cost of a half-day guest teacher for Mr. Magoni and Mrs. Boutilier.
