Alaska Performance Scholarship – 2024 Outcomes Report

JUNEAU- The [Alaska Performance Scholarship \(APS\) 2024 Outcomes Report](#) is now available for review. This report reflects APS eligibility and usage trends from Fall 2011 – Fall 2023. Highlights from this report include:

- Eligibility of 17% remains at the program’s lowest since inception
- APS recipients are two times more likely to graduate with a bachelor’s degree
- 95% of APS recipients remain Alaska residents two years after graduation
