# Venue

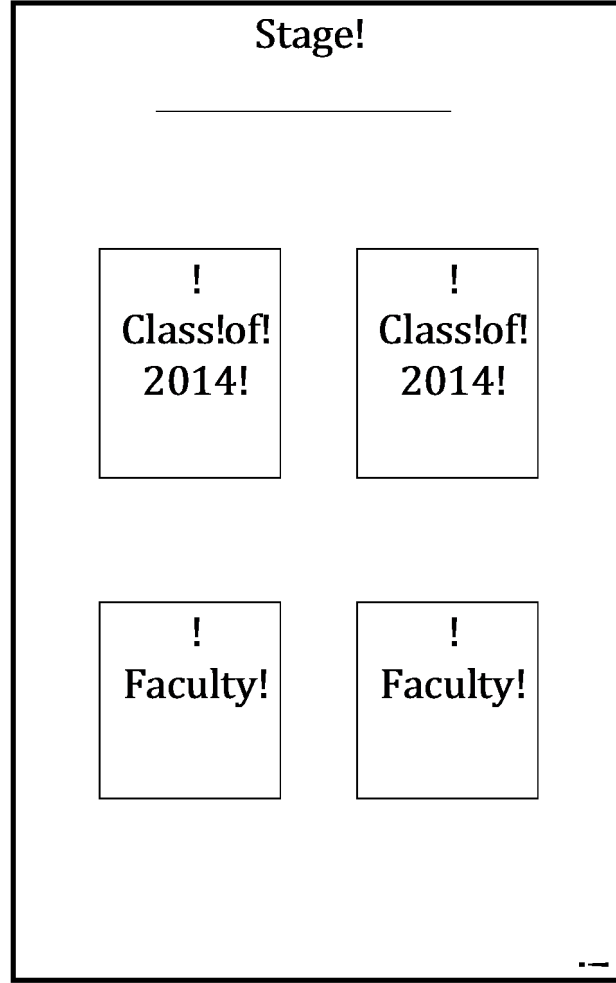
- Surveyed students
