This note is added (or attached) to the minutes of the January 15, 2026 organizational meeting of the Board of Education as a legal reference to the change in status of our school district caused by the Revised School Code (MCL 380.1 et seq) amendments, which became effective July 1, 1996.

1. Legal name of School District Peck Community Schools
2. Prior to July 1, 1996, this district was classified as a fourth class school district. On July 1, 1996 the district became a general powers school district by operation of law.
3. The Board of Education is comprised of 7 members who are elected for terms of 6 years.
