



Greetings from your HV Career Center:

Here is your to-do list for November-

- 1. Complete your FAFSA if you have not finished it yet. The "bucket of free money" is given out based on when you submit your FAFSA, so if you are too late, the free money will be gone.
- 2. This is College Application Week. NOW is the time to start applying to both colleges and/or trade schools. Schools also give out "free money" based on need or merit, but they also run out if you wait too long. Every school is different, so check your deadlines. Come in to B1 if you have questions!

3. OSAC is open at:

www.oregonstudentaid.gov

This is a single application to over 400 Oregon-specific scholarships. It is not due until February, but you can start it NOW...it is a long one. You will need: 4 personal statements (found on the website), an activities chart, and 4 letters of recommendation. Come see us in B1 if you have questions.

4. OREGON PROMISE is open now. Find it at:

www.oregonstudentaid.gov

This is the program offering free or reduced tuition at Oregon Community Colleges to lower to middle income students to Oregon residents. You MUST list each community college on your FAFSA to receive the Oregon Promise grant. The grant does not take long, so get it done!

5. Our next College Help Night is Thursday, December 7th from 3:00-7:00pm. We will be here it assist with FAFSA, college applications and scholarship applications. If you have questions, stop in to see us in B1 or email me at:
