Recommendation:

Approve the revised Gifted and Talented Program Screening Matrix to ensure compliance with Texas State Plan for the Education of Gifted/Talented (GT) Students as follows:

- 1.5.1C – Data collected from multiple sources for each area of giftedness served by the district are included in the assessment process for GT services
- 1.5.4C – In grades 1-12, qualitative and quantitative data are collected through three (3) or more measures and used to determine whether or not a student needs GT services.

Rationale:

The revised matrix allows for students to be screened for identification based on the following:

- 1. Aptitude Test – Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test (same as before),
- 2. Cognitive Abilities Test – CogAT 7 (new assessment and replaces the need for student portfolios),
- 3. Student Grades (same as before), and
- 4. Parent/Teacher Checklist (same as before)

Budgetary Information:

The budgetary amount for scoring portfolios will now be used to provide the new assessment to students nominated for GT testing.
