

# Technology Report

April, 2012

This month in technology we have worked on the following projects:

- Worked with the District Testing Coordinator in preparing labs and monitoring the TELPAS test online for students from all three campuses.
- Worked with Mrs. Jackson and Mrs. Savala at OES training them on the use of search functions with the video surveillance system.
- Worked with maintenance and the Crockett County Sheriff's Office in the recovery of the damaged digital video recorder from the Intermediate School, replaced the DVR with one I had on hand from the OHS portable buildings and set it up at OIS, then worked with Kay Gee Security to replace the damaged cameras and install an updated alarm system at OIS, the system is installed and active.
- Worked with DAEP relocating student computers and Mr. Hawthorne's computer and phone to the OMS portable building, setting up computers and installing a network printer so DAEP students can continue with computer assignments.
- Scheduled delivery for new Distance Learning Equipment from I2I technologies for last week of April. We will be receiving 4 new Distance Learning Stations from a USDA grant that we participated in about two years ago.
- Worked with teachers offering at least weekly trainings on subjects such as Mimio, ExamView Software, Einstruction and other programs used by the district.

- Assisted Superintendent by setting up equipment for budget workshop meetings at OES.

- Continually upgrade the calendars, tweets, post a weekly newsletter and posting notices on the district webpage.
- Attended training on the new Microsoft License agreement so we can hopefully save money by restructuring our agreement with Microsoft.
- Assisted campuses in scheduling and Distance Learning field trips and storytelling adventures.
- Worked at OES adjusting the electronic doors. There are still some issues with a couple of the entry systems.
- Repair circulation computer at OES and reconfigure software.
