Claims;

- Howdy to all. February is over and we are almost into spring. Our breakfast and lunch numbers for February are as follows. We served 17, 671 for breakfast. The daily average was 1,040. For lunch we served 45,100 and our daily average was 2,653. Last year we served 40,674 for lunch and the daily average was 2,542. We are showing an increase of 111 servings per day this year for lunch. We will compare our breakfast numbers to January of 2019. We served 17,533 in January of 2019 and we served 17,671 in February 2019. That is an increase of 138 servings for breakfast and we served 17 days in February and 18 days in January. We are still trying new items almost every month.
- We had a reimbursement for the month of February of \$143,205.98 and last years was \$142,127.43.

Projects;

- We have finished repairing freezer #1 at the warehouse. We will start it back up on March 7th. If everything works right after startup we will start to transfer food from freezer #2 into freezer #1 so that we can turn off #2 for repairs.
- They are finishing the new locks on our door as I am typing this report on March 5th. It will be nice to have the locks completed for our office and warehouse.
- We will be completing our Summer Food Program application this month and probably finish our NSLP & SBP application this month of March also.
