



BEAVERTON SCHOOL DISTRICT INTER-DISTRICT TRANSFER PROCESS, 2018-2019**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Senate Bill 709 was enacted by the February 2015 Legislature, providing new rules for school choice for Oregon students. Senate Bill 709 will be applied to the 2018–2019 school year.

The proposal for 2018-2019 Inter-District transfers is as follows:

- Approval of all seniors into, and out of, Beaverton School District
- Approval of hardship requests into, and out of, Beaverton School District. Hardships, as defined by Senate Bill 709, would be for student health and/or safety interests.
- Preference will be given to non-resident students who are on an approved Mid-School Year Move for the 2017-18 school year, and who meet attendance and behavioral expectations.
- Unfilled BSD Open-Enrollment slots will be open for Inter-District transfers at the following schools:

Fir Grove Elementary - 25

- 6 students @ grade 3
- 13 students @ grade 4
- 6 students @ grade 5

Greenway Elementary – 25

- 5 students @ kdg.
- 5 students @ grade 1
- 5 students @ grade 2
- 5 students @ grade 3
- 5 students @ grade 4

McKay Elementary – 25

- 4 students @ kdg.
- 4 students @ grade 1
- 13 students @ grade 2
- 4 students @ grade 4

Terra Linda Elementary – 19

- 3 students @ kdg.
- 4 students @ grade 1
- 6 students @ grade 4
- 6 students @ grade 5

Whitford Middle School – 15

- 5 students @ grade 6
- 5 students @ grade 7
- 5 students @ grade 8
