

FEEDBACK FROM PARENT SURVEY

Survey sent to all parents and open for one week.

1083 responses out of 2158 students = 50% participation rate.

Responses are reasonably evenly distributed proportionally across the two groups.

Number of Remote Learners as of 10/13/20 = 303
