What is an IB Education






IB Schools and Programmes

• The IB offers four programmes for students aged 3 to 19.

• Offered worldwide, across 4,964 schools in 153 countries.

- The largest region is The Americas (2,932 schools).
- Canyon del Oro offers the Diploma Programme beginning in Grade 11.













IB at Canyon del Oro High School

- CDO was authorized in February of 2012
- CDO's first Diploma Programme graduating class was in May of 2014
- CDO is in its 6th year as a IB World School, offering the full Diploma Programme and the Certificate pathway
- Students can take individual classes in the "Certificate Pathway" or the full "Diploma Programme"








CDO IB Programme Overview

- Requires full DP students to take World Language all 4 years
- Offers highest levels of Math and Science beyond AP courses
- Preparation for CLEP exams
- Alignment with honors level college programs
- Promotes experiential learning and real word leadership development
- Student choice in designing course options







IB Options at CDO

Full Diploma

- Student take 6 subjects
- Students take IB Core
 components that includes a
 theory of knowledge class,
 extended research paper, and
 service learning component

Certificate Pathway

 Students take 1-3 IB subjects, in conjunction with other programs offered at CDO (AP, CTE, JTED, etc.)





Full Diploma in Focus

- The full Diploma is acknowledged worldwide as a rigorous college preparatory programme.
- Students complete six honors level classes, and the IB Core

IB Core

- Extended Essay requires students to engage in independent research and create an extended work (3,500 -4,000 words)
- Theory of Knowledge (TOK) develops a coherent approach to learning and critical thinking
- Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) emphasises helping students to develop
 their own identities, and leadership skills

Students in the IB Diploma Programme study 6 subjects and can attain a maximum of 7 points in each subject. Three additional points may be earned by completing the core Diploma required assessment components of Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge course. Candidates can thereby attain **a maximum score of 45 points** in the Diploma Programme.

IB Tuition Scholarship

- \$5,000 annual tuition scholarship available to students completing the full Diploma with minimum passing scores
- University of Arizona and Northern Arizona University began offering for 2017-2018 school year
- 15 students currently eligible representing \$20,000 per student
- Potential IB Tuition scholarships represent \$300,000 for the past two graduating cohorts





College Acceptance Rate

- 96% (123 of 128 total students) of all CDO IB DP and Certificate graduates have gone on to a 2- or 4- year college to continue their studies
- 94% of those went on to a 4-year university (8 students chose to start at Pima)
- 75% of those chose to attend one of our in-state public universities and 25% chose to attend an out-of-state and/or private university
- The 5 students who did not immediately go on to further their education did the following:
 - 2 returned to Singapore to fulfill their military duty (1 of those has already returned after two years to attend the U of A)
 - 1 joined AmeriCorps for one year prior to attending an out-of-state university
 - 2 took gap years 1 to earn her pilot's license before attending the U of A, and 1 to travel in Europe before settling in a university in Germany








Open Enrollment

families acknowledged IB for joining CDO during 2018 open enrollment






Vision for growth

- Promote both full IB Diploma and Certificate Pathway to provide students greater access to appropriately challenging courses
- Full DP student numbers have fluctuated (blue color)
- Certificate Pathway student numbers have increased (orange color)

significantly

- 2017 -2019 cohort, 19 students
 - 5% of seniors taking IB courses
- 2018 2020 cohort, 46 students
 - 12% of seniors taking IB courses
- 2019 2021 cohort pending





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District Commitment

- Annual fee of approximately \$12,000
- Professional Development and Training annual allocation: \$10,000
- 17 IB Teachers utilizing 3.2 FTE throughout the day, some classes layered with other appropriate subjects
- 1 full time IB Coordinator





Programme Status

- All IB schools are required to conduct an extensive self-study and submit 5-year reviews for continued authorization.
- The process takes in excess of one year, and was completed in February 2019.
- Canyon del Oro maintains an IB Action plan based on IB Programme Standards and Practices.
- The IB Action Plan is updated annually and after the self-study completion for IB submission and feedback.
