Update:

The Educator Supports team launched the 2025–2026 school year with a robust slate of professional learning opportunities aimed at empowering educators for a strong start. These offerings included coaching, consulting, and customized in-district sessions designed to foster collaboration and innovation grounded in research-based practices.

Reach and Impact

- Over 30 professional learning sessions were delivered across:
 - 8 in-county districts
 - 3 out-of-county districts
 - 4 countywide sessions
 - 3 KRESA programs
 - 1 statewide Social Studies Summit
- 26 sessions were specifically tailored for in-county districts.
- Over 300 participating educators

Focus Areas

Sessions addressed a wide range of educator needs, including:

- Literacy and Mathematics
- Curriculum and Instructional Practices
- Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) and Behavior
- Technology/STEM Integration
- Early Childhood Education
- MICIP (Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process)
- Multilingual Learner Support
- Engagement (Inclusion)
