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# Special Education

# Current Special Ed Numbers

- Total # Sped: **134**
  - End of year for Pre K- 6th grade
- # of PPTs held since August 2022: **407**

# Referrals to Special Education

- **Total Referrals: 59**
- **# Parent Referrals: 29**
  - Did not suspect disability/evaluate: **12**
  - Evaluated: **17** 29% eligible, 59% not eligible, 2 Pending
- **# School Referrals: 21**
  - Did not evaluate: **1**
  - Evaluated: **20** 80% eligible, 20% not eligible
- **# Out of District Referrals (Pre-K, Birth 2-3, Private School): 9**
  - Did not evaluate: **1**
  - Evaluated: **8** 50% eligible, 38% not eligible, 1 Pending
- **New Eligibilities: 24** (not always attending BRS)

# Referrals and PPTs

- Slightly lower than anticipated (referrals and PPTs)
- SRBI process completed during the entire year
  - Substitute pool/ building subs
- Higher percentage of Special Education eligibility comes from School Referrals through the SRBI process
- Full number of PPTs/eligible students is based on students entering/exiting throughout the school year

# Talented and Gifted (TAG)

## **NNAT- 2**

- Grade 3: 119 students participated in Round 1
- Grade 4 and 5: 24 students participated in Round 1
  - Some repeat from previous year
  - Some students moved in to district.

## **SAGES- 3**

- Grade 3- 11% of grade participated in assessment, all eligible TAG
- Grade 4 and 5- 16% of the 24 students from round 1 participated, 75% eligible TAG

## **Renzulli Scales**

- Administered for all students taking SAGES-3 and considered in eligibility

## **Notification**

- Families notified in June of scores/eligibility
