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Special Education

Current Special Ed Numbers

- Total # Sped: **134**
 - End of year for Pre K- 6th grade

of PPTs held since August 2022: 407

Referrals to Special Education

- Total Referrals: 59
- # Parent Referrals: 29
 - Did not suspect disability/evaluate: 12
 - Evaluated: 17 29% eligible, 59% not eligible, 2 Pending
- # School Referrals: 21
 - Did not evaluate: 1
 - Evaluated: 20 80% eligible, 20% not eligible
- # Out of District Referrals (Pre-K, Birth 2-3, Private School): 9
 - Did not evaluate: 1
 - Evaluated: 8 50% eligible, 38% not eligible, 1 Pending
- New Eligibilities: 24 (not always attending BRS)

Referrals and PPTs

- Slightly lower than anticipated (referrals and PPTs)
- SRBI process completed during the entire year
 - Substitute pool/ building subs
- Higher percentage of Special Education eligibility comes from School Referrals through the SRBI process
- Full number of PPTs/eligible students is based on students entering/exiting throughout the school year

Talented and Gifted (TAG)

NNAT- 2

- Grade 3: 119 students participated in Round 1
- Grade 4 and 5: 24 students participated in Round 1
 - Some repeat from previous year
 - Some students moved in to district.

SAGES 3

- Grade 3- 11% of grade participated in assessment, all eligible TAG
- Grade 4 and 5- 16% of the 24 students from round 1 participated,
 75% eligible TAG

Renzulli Scales

 Administered for all students taking SAGES-3 and considered in eligibility
