March Highlights

**Culture:**

- In March, we celebrated healthy minds and bodies by enjoying field day with peers all around the state! We also had a virtual event where students in every grade level played games about making healthy choices.
  - TOPS onboarded one more cohort of students grades 3-6 in March.
- We measure three critical behaviors that students are expected to complete within their first days enrolled. These behaviors represent the habits we need students to build right from the start in order to be successful in virtual school.
- 100% of students have logged in within their first 3 days. Students need to build a habit around daily login.
  - 91% of students have responded to a personal connection from their teacher within their first 10 days. Students need to build a habit around frequent communication with their teachers.
  - 93% of students have completed their orientation course within their first 5 days. Students need to build a habit around making routine progress in their asynchronous coursework.

**Academics:**

- Teacher teams continued planning their re-teach and review in preparation for testing season. They used interim 2 data to identify any remaining misconceptions on highest tested content to plan reteach accordingly. They utilized Lead4Ward's Rockin' Review process to plan 10-day review.
- Current pass rate: 77%
- Current engagement rate (takes progress in the asynchronous course into account): 85%
