The boys track team finished 2nd at the sectional track meet on May 18th. The girls track team finished 3rd at the sectional track meet on May 11th. Team members who qualified for the state meet: Daylee – Long Jump (4th Place and new school record 17' 3.75") and Triple Jump (DNP); Madison Hilbert – Pole Vault (DNP); Claudia 1600M Run (4th Place), 3200M Run (3rd Place); Hollie Johnson – 400M Run (9th Place); 4 x 100M Relay (DNP); 4 x 200M Relay (DNP), 4 x 400M Relay (4th Place). As a team the Lady Panthers placed 6th!!!
