

Bid Summary:

On Wednesday, April 14, 2010 the District received two (2) sealed bids for the proposed COPS Grant – Security Surveillance and Card Access System expansion. Specifications were sent out directly to nineteen (19) potential bidders and six (6) attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting on Monday, March 22, 2010 (see attached lists).

Recommendation:

I am recommending that this project be awarded to the low bidder *Security Designs, Inc.* with a bid of \$282,304. Second bid from *EO Integrated Systems, Inc.*, was for the amount \$ 418,755.

Rationale:

Security Designs, Inc., is an experienced security vendor, met all bid requirements and submittals and attended the mandatory pre-bid meeting.

Subject: Supplemental Security Bid – Project IAMS 200 Cooper/Johnson

As part of the COPS Federal Grant Security Project, we included a second and separate project for similar equipment to be installed at Cooper 5/6 Upper Elementary and Johnson 5/6 Upper Elementary. Since these two schools do not reside in the City of Livonia proper, they are not eligible under the grant awarded and administered through the City of Livonia Police Department.

Low bid for project IAMS 200 was received from *Security Designs, Inc.*, for the amount of \$39,088. Second bid was from *EO Integrated Systems, Inc.* in the amount of \$48,478.

District will have to evaluate and decide if funds are available to include these two schools. If not, they would be the only two instructional schools not on the security network. See attachment for additional information.
