### **Student Achievement**


Students in District 13 will demonstrate academic growth from Fall to Spring using RIT scores from the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) tests.

Strategies will be developed to support the social emotional well being of students and staff.







### MAP Reading RIT: Cohort




### MAP Math RIT: Cohort




# D13 Fall 2022 - Winter 2023 MAP Cohort Growth

## Reading RIT Scores Fall 22- Spring 23




## COMMUNICATION

## Indicators of Success:

- > District Leadership Council has met 9/20, 10/18, 11/15, and 1/17 so far this year;
- > Annual Report is scheduled to be released to the community by the end of the month;
- > The Community Collaboration Group has met on 9/20 and 12/20;
- > Board members have received text, email, regular newsletters and face to face meetings for updates;
- > Community messaging has been through monthly email, social media, a fall forum, and a survey.

## SOCIAL EMOTIONAL SUPPORT

Develop and implement strategies to better support the social emotional well being of students and staff.



## Indicators of Success:

- > Elementary students have received Second Step support while Middle school students had used Suite 360 since the beginning of the year;
- > The staffing plan will be released to the Board and Community at the end of March;
- > Insightex survey was administered in November;
- > Connection Card survey was administered, safe school helpline data is collected throughout the year;
- > Coffees have been implemented monthly since September.
