Curriculum and Instruction

Spring universal screening in reading and math occurred in grades K-8 in May and data from the screenings will be used by district and campus administrators to gauge student academic growth in reading, math, and language usage throughout the district.

Summer school has begun across the district for students along with the summer feeding program.

State Assessments

The district has received preliminary results for EOC assessments and grades 5 & 8 STAAR. Our HS biology and US history students and teachers should be applauded for their accomplishments. Our 5th and 8th grade are to be commended on the marked improvement from first round scores to second round scores. We are awaiting the preliminary scores for grades 3-8. More information will be forthcoming as scores are released and data is disaggregated.

Professional Development

The conference was sponsored in part by Raise Your Hand Texas and focused on blended/personalized learning, literacy, social/emotional learning and Texas Tech partnerships.

District and campus leadership traveled to Houston to Cy-Fair ISD's annual 3R Leadership Conference on June 4, 5 and 6. The conference focused on the importance of the 3Rs- Rigor, Relevance and Relationships.
