The Process




- As a result of many years of planning and leadership efforts by community members, parents, volunteers, and Denton ISD team members, the 2023 bond includes a rebuild of Ginnings Elementary
- Determination was made that the site of Ginnings Elementary will not accommodate a rebuild without the demolition of the current building
- Meetings were held with Ginnings faculty and staff members
- Community meetings are held on two nights:
 - Monday, Nov. 18
 - Tuesday, Dec. 3
- Board workshop on Tuesday, Dec.10 to discuss drafts and potential revisions based on community feedback
- If changes are made, the new draft maps will be posted on the district website at <u>www.dentonisd.org/Ginnings2025</u>
- New attendance boundaries will go into effect for the 2025-2026 school year; finalized attendance boundary maps will be posted on the district website


