

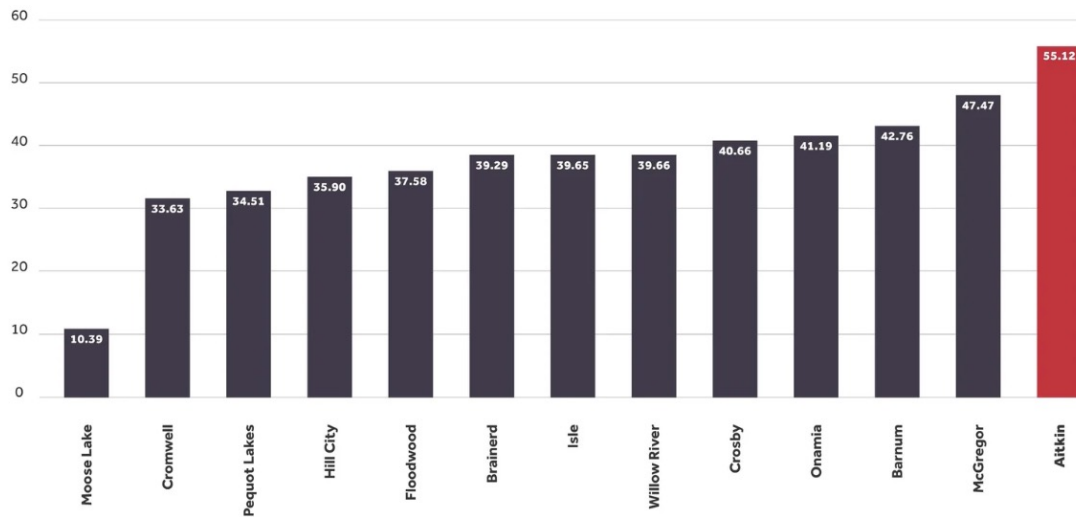

4 voter referendum fail

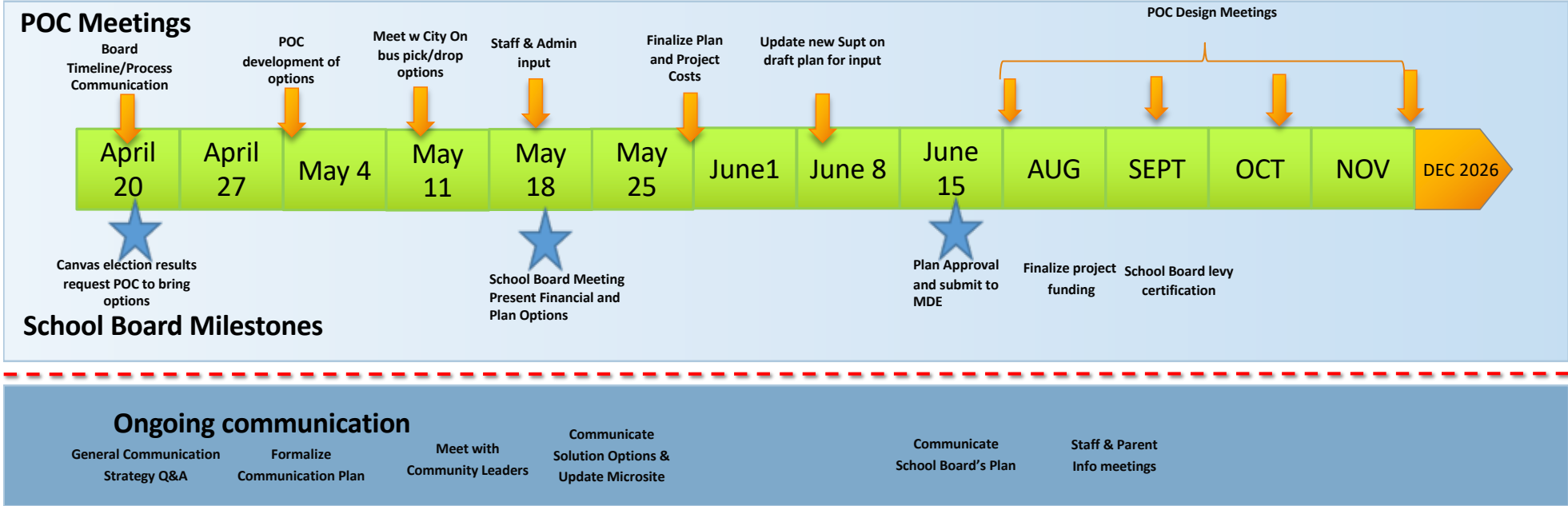
