Subject: Consider Approval of Policy FFA(LOCAL): Student Welfare: Wellness and Health Services - FIRST READING				
<b>Background:</b> This policy was reviewed by the Policy Committee on June 2, 2010. The recommended change to this policy is to remove language referring to CATCH (Coordinated Approach to Child Health) which is a coordinated health program with a nutrition education component for elementary schools. The replacement language is broader and not specific to CATCH. This allows the District to adopt and implement a coordinated school health program that meets state guidelines in both elementary and intermediate schools. If approved, the policy will be brought to the Board for a second reading at a subsequent Board meeting.
