Option C

Calendar A:

- Provides a clear endpoint before June, which may benefit summer planning.
- May create a time crunch for end-of-year activities and final assessments.
- Aligns well with summer college class schedules for staff and students.

Calendar B:

- Maintains familiarity, making transition easier for students, staff, and families.
- A May not address concerns or desired improvements from past schedules.
- Consistency with the current year may support stability in academic pacing.
- Includes one Friday in May as a school day, which may be an adjustment for families.
- Adds a soft start, which may ease students and staff into the academic year smoothly.

Calendar C:

- Aligns well with local culture and subsistence activities in August.
- Later start means a later finish in June, which may impact summer plans.
- Could support better student attendance and engagement early in the year.
- Adds a soft start, which may ease students and staff into the academic year
- Many college semesters start June 1st, so this may be difficult for students and staff balancing both schedules.
