Attached is Spring Trip request for the Odessa High School Band for the 2005-06 school year. We would like to take the Band to Branson, MO from April 21-24, 2006 to perform a festival and enjoy a variety of other activities. Our goal here at Odessa High School is to provide our students with unique opportunities that might not otherwise be available to them. This trip will be both musically and culturally rewarding for the students in our program, and we thank you for your consideration of this proposal.

Musically, the band students will be performing at the Ozark Showcase of Music Festival for a panel of distinguished judges who will record and write comments about areas of the perfromance in need of improvement. In addition, each group will have a small clinic with one of the panelists who will be able to address the issues on the spot. This activity will help the students become better at critiquing their own playing, which in turn will help the group as a whole.

In addition to the performances, the band will be experiencing many other activities including a performance of a Broadway style show (*Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat*), the Dixie Stampede Dinner and Western Show and the Showboat Branson Belle Dinner Show, a trip on a historic Paddle Wheeler complete with a meal and live entertainment. We will drive overnight to Branson, spend one night in Branson, and then drive overnight coming home. This schedule helps keep the cost of the trip down for each student, and allows us to make the trip with very limited time away from school. Rather than 2 days, the students will only lose one day of classes.

Attached is a tentative breakdown of the projected number of students who will participate, the number of sponsors involved, the cost of the trip, and the preliminary list of fundraisers that will be used to raise the necessary funds. Also included is a preliminary schedule for the trip. As stated above, our goal is to provide the students in the band opportunities that many of them would not get outside of the organization.
