The Hidden Valley High School Band is requesting permission for out or state travel to attend the Western International Band Clinic (WIBC). WIBC is held at the Doubletree Hotel in Seattle Washington. The convention will take place on November 20-23rd, 2009.

For the 5th year in a row members of the Hidden Valley High School Band have auditioned to participate in the Western International Band Clinic (WIBC). To be accepted into WIBC students must submit a high quality recording of a standardized piece of music literature that will judged by a panel of musical professionals. In the course of submitting a quality audition students have spent countless hours of practicing along with several hours of supervised recording. Acceptance to WIBC is an honor for the student and the school they represent Registration, room and meals will be paid for with Professional Development funds for Ben Lawson. Students will pay for registration (includes room) and their own food.
