Please state your proposal briefly and clearly. What do you want the board to know, discuss, or decide?

Dave Valenzuela requesting permission for out-of-state travel for up to six TRSD Employees to attend the Edupoint National Users Conference focusing on Synergy, the District's student information system. The participants would include Pete DelVaglio - Network Programmer, Robert Saunders - Technology Supervisor/TOSA, Michelle Pitts - Curriculum Office Manager, Danielle Reece - Special Education Coordinator, Lisa Beteta - Special Education Coordinator and a Building Administrator. This conference is being held in Anaheim, California on November 3rd and 4th. This conference has proven to be extremely valuable and informative to our support staff. Given it's past value, it was anticipated that we would attend and budgeted for ahead of time.

Provide history/background information on your proposal.

Synergy has been our student information system (SIS) for several years now, but changes constantly. Synergy supports and incredible amount of data and information for our district and it is critical that it functions according to district needs. Synergy is going through a significant upgrade from version 10+. This will impact many features and the general user experience. Three Rivers is also moving to Synergy SE, the Special Education Records module of Synergy. This conference is designed to give our key personnel the support they need to address the new features as well fix any issues we are currently dealing with.

List the advantages of your proposal:

By sending a team to the National Users Conference, we will receive hands on training from the foremost experts on the latest and most pertinent features of Synergy. From state reporting and Sped records management to final grades/report cards; there will be a number of new features and functions to learn. Last year we built our curriculum and technology department budgets with this conference in mind and have planned accordingly.

List possible disadvantages of your proposal:

Traveling out of state can be expensive and viewed as superfluous by some. This year's National User's Conference is in Anaheim, CA and being held at the Disneyland Hotel (not in the resort itself, just at the Hotel). We do not get to choose where a conference is held, we can only gauge the value to our users and determine the viability of this conference to our district. There is no other conference of this type offered by Edupoint.
