Background Information

An Emergency Temporary Standard (ETS) requiring vaccinations or testing is currently in place, but the Supreme Court is hearing a challenge on January 7th. If the current rule stands, the district needs a plan to require all employees to be vaccinated or a plan to require all employees to either be vaccinated or tested on a weekly basis. According to the Minnesota School Boards Association (MSBA), a policy needs to be in place on or before Monday, January 10th.

If required, the Superintendent's recommendation is to adopt a policy that allows employees to either be vaccinated or tested on a weekly basis. The testing program would be fully implemented by February 9th. The recommended policy is largely based on a model policy developed by the MSBA.

In Red Wing, policies are typically adopted only after a first and second reading. However, policies may be adopted on an emergency basis; in that case, a policy expires after one year.
