Reconstitution Plan 2013-14

The requirements for the Hood Jr. High reconstitution plan includes the actions that have already happened in the voluntary reconstitution that the district with the support of the PSP Dr. Karen Case implemented. The teachers and administrators from the campus were all interviewed for positions on the campus and decision were made to keep them or let them go if they did not meet the standards for retention at the New Hood Jr. High.

The school was also moving toward block scheduling but it was not effective last school year so the campus is moving back to traditional class schedules.

Project Based Learning was implemented with at least a couple of projects conducted during the year. Training in PBL was conducted for the campus faculty members that were selected to participate in this program.

The 9th grade class was moved to two other jr. high campuses but as the district was working to move toward the middle school model the move could not happen in 2014 so the 9th graders were moved back to Hood for the next two years since the 3 new elementary schools are opening in the fall of 2015.

For the current year Hood has started the PBIS/Champs program to help support discipline on the campus. The training was provided school wide for all the team members.

A very strong focus is being placed on curriculum and alignment through unit assessments and benchmarks. Administrators will be conducting walkthroughs to monitor delivery and rigor. The campus will be having data talks and PLCs to hold everybody accountable.
