

Denton Independent School District
Impact Resistant Window Film Purchase

SUMMARY:

This item requests approval of the quote from Epic Solar Control in the amount of \$440,000.00 for the purchase and installation of 3M impact resistant film at all school campuses and the C.H. Collins Athletic Stadium.

BOARD GOAL:

PREVIOUS BOARD ACTION:

None

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Denton ISD applied for and was awarded by TEA, a School Safety and Security Grant for \$488,164 in November 2019. Several vendors were sought out and sent to 40 campuses and the C.H. Collins Athletic Stadium to take the necessary measurements for quotes.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES:

The purchase and installation of the 3M impact resistant film will be purchased from Epic Solar Control through a Texas Local Governmental Purchasing Cooperative BuyBoard contract. This purchase is being brought for approval in accordance with the District's CH (local) policy.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS:

The cost will be borne through the Safety and Security Grant budget.

BENEFIT OF ACTION:

The installation of 3M window film will act as an additional security measure at our campus entrances by slowing down intruders while affording more time for first responders to arrive.

SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the quote from Epic Solar Control in the amount of \$440,000.00 for the purchase and installation of 3M impact resistant film at all school campuses and the C.H. Collins Athletic Stadium be accepted.
