**RE:** Harlem School District IGA with RVC for Dual/Articulated Credit

**Date:** May 5, 2022

Harlem School District and Rock Valley College (RVC) have an intergovernmental agreement to allow students from Harlem School District to enroll in dual and articulated credit courses at Harlem High School that lead to both high school and college credits. The renewal contract encompasses the following changes:

- 1. Allow RVC chief academic officer or designee, in consultation with the Harlem superintendent or designee, to conduct a course evaluation in alignment with RVC's review and evaluation policies and procedures. The evaluation shall not impact the instructor's performance evaluation under the School Code..
- 2. RVC will share student evaluation and performance data with Harlem. The information provided by RVC shall not impact the instructor's performance evaluation under the School Code.
- 3. Harlem will share a GoogleSheet with a list of students who are taking dual and articulated credit courses indicating which students have a 504 or IEP. The accommodations for the student will be indicated on the shared GoogleSheet.
- 4. Students with IEP's and 504's will receive access to the accommodations and aids included in their plan.
- 5. Regular communication will be established about student progress, performance, and individual needs of students with IEP's and 504's.
- 6. Each party identified within the agreement and the employees of the party shall maintain confidentiality of all personally identifiable information concerning students enrolled in dual and articulated credit courses.
