**ITEM: IV.**

**TOPIC:           Approval to Purchase Emergency Replacement Bus**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Move that the Board of Education of the Livonia Public Schools School District accept the recommendation to make an emergency purchase of one 2017 Blue Bird Micro Mini school bus from Holland Motor Homes and Buses, Holland, Michigan, for a cost of \$51,000; \$39,500 of that amount will come from the District's insurance company, therefore the final cost to the District will be \$11,500.

**RATIONALE:**

This bus purchase will replace a bus that was in an accident in August 2018 and deemed by the school district's insurance company to be a total loss. The original cost of the bus is \$51,000.00; however the school district is receiving a settlement of \$39,500.00 from the insurance company for the damaged bus, so the final total cost to the school district is \$11,500.00.
