Subject: Increase EMS Student Testing Fee for AEMT and Paramedic Students

Recommendation: Approve EMS Student Testing Fee Increase, effective July 1, 2024

Background and Rationale:

The National Registry of Emergency Medical Services will increase student testing fees starting July 1, 2024. The fee increase only impacts the AEMT and Paramedic students. The request is to increase each testing fee to match the National Registry fee increase. The last increase by the NREMT's was in January 2023.

Below is the current testing fee, the fee increase for all four testing levels, and the courses in which to tie the fee:

- AEMT from \$144.00 to \$159.00 (\$15.00 increase); add fee to EMSP 2260
- Paramedic from \$160 to \$175.00 (\$15.00 increase); add fee to EMSP 2264

A testing voucher will be provided to each program graduate allowing the graduate to sit for the Registry exam.

Cost and Budgetary Support: No cost to WCJC; student fee covers the cost of the Registry exam
