A. School Safety – A community forum concerning school safety will be held on March 19 at 7 p.m. in the high school media center. The district is one of only about twenty in the state that has a complete safety plan filed with the state. A safety audit was conducted in all four schools about four years ago. Another will be requested. The discussion included having a joint effort between Boards to fund additional SROs. The Sandy Hook Promise Foundation provides free training for student and staff and has a short video on their website. The shift patterns for our police were outlined, and it is estimated that the yearly cost of an SRO is \$130,000. Bullying issues also continue to be addressed. Safety measures that have been put into place were briefly reviewed.
