RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Town of Horizon City ("City) is a political subdivision of the State of

Texas;

WHEREAS, The Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority ("CRRMA") is a regional

mobility authority created pursuant to the request of the City of El Paso and operating pursuant to

Chapter 370 of the Texas Transportation Code and is a body politic and corporate and a political

subdivision of the State of Texas;

WHEREAS, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code provides that any one or more

public agencies may contract with each other for the performance of governmental functions or

services in which the contracting parties are mutually interested;

WHEREAS, Chapter 370 of the Texas Transportation Code permits the CRRMA to enter

into an agreement under which the CRRMA may acquire, plan, design, construct, maintain, repair,

or operate a transportation project on behalf of another governmental entity if the transportation

project is located in the CRRMA's area of jurisdiction or in a county adjacent to the CRRMA's

area of jurisdiction;

WHERAS, the City desires to enter into an interlocal agreement with the CRRMA to allow

the CRRMA to provide the following services: appraisal, appraisal Review, title, right of way

project management, survey (metes and bounds) and negotiation services for the Horizon City

Transit Center acquisition of seven (7) parcels and other types of Right of Way review services for

Town of Horizon City Delake ROW Project; and

WHEREAS, the City and the CRRMA desire to enter into an interlocal agreement to allow for the CRRMA to complete the services requested by the City for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town of Horizon City Council resolves as follows: That the Mayor is authorized to sign the Interlocal Agreement Project Development Agreement between the Town of Horizon City, Texas and the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority in an amount not to exceed \$278,538.75
