ENERGY EFFICIENCY AUDIT FINDINGS:

Executive Director of Finance and Operations Todd Lechtenberg and inBYLT representative Cody Capra shared the findings of the recent guaranteed energy savings audit. It was noted that effective January 1, 2026, the sale of fluorescent lamps will be banned in the State of

Minnesota, requiring the district to convert to LED lighting. In addition to the

lighting upgrade, the proposed project would include applying

weatherization including weather stripping at all sites and destratification fans at five sites. The project, estimated at \$2,776,336, will be presented

for approval at the regular April 14 school board meeting.

ENERGY SAVINGS FUNDING REVIEW:

Todd Lechtenberg and PMA Securities Representative Michael Hart

outlined the two potential funding sources for the energy savings project and the advantages of utilizing capital facilities bonds over capital funds.

Utilizing capital facilities bonds would have no tax impact on most

properties. The funding recommendation would be brought to the board for

approval pending the approval of the energy saving project.
