Re: Campus Safety Audits – 3-year Cycle

Keeping students and staff safe while on district property is the highest priority for both the district and the State of Texas. Over the past two years, the Texas School Safety Center and the Texas Education Agency have conducted Intruder Detection Audits (IDA) at each of our campuses. These audits assess whether a campus is accessible to an unauthorized individual and help districts identify opportunities for safety improvements.

Additionally, the district has completed its required three-year Safety and Security Audit process in accordance with Texas Education Code §37.108. We continue to work closely with our School Safety and Security Committee to ensure staff are well-trained and that campus facilities are properly secured. Intruder detection audits and safety reviews are just part of a broader, ongoing effort to strengthen campus security.

We understand that parents and community members are interested in the results of these audits. However, sharing specific details publicly could compromise campus security. For that reason, detailed findings are reviewed in executive session and were discussed during the Safety and Security Committee meeting earlier this month.

Clear Creek ISD remains committed to providing a safe and secure learning environment for all students and staff, and we will continue to make improvements to our security practices.
