Academic Progress

Our second graders took spring benchmark tests last week and we are working on making plans to address this data in PLCs. Preliminary data is the following:

Math (cut scores of Approaching 44%, Meets 60% & Masters 80%)

Student results:

Approaching: 95%
Meets: 86%
Masters: 54%

21 students were within 1 question of hitting the masters cut score.

Special Ed, EB and Eco Dis sub pops remain areas of target.

Challenging TEKS:

2.3B explain that the more fractional parts used to make a whole, the smaller the part; and the fewer the fractional parts, the larger the part;

2.4A recall basic facts to add and subtract within 20 with automaticity

2.4B add up to four two-digit numbers and subtract two-digit numbers using mental strategies and algorithms based on knowledge of place value and properties of operations

2.4C solve one-step and multi-step word problems involving addition and subtraction within 1,000 using a variety of strategies based on place value, including algorithms

Reading

*We are still scoring constructed responses and should have complete data by the end of the week.

*Important to note that the spring benchmark is not read orally to students unless they have formal accommodations for questions and answer choices to be read aloud. Students must read the passage independently. (Mirrors 3rd Gr STAAR accommodations)
