#### **Kelly Lane School Goals:**

1.1 - <u>Achievement Goal</u> - Increase reading and math achievement scores based on fall assessment data on DIBELS (K-2) and STAR (Grade 2) scores by spring 2022.

#### Math and Reading:

- Establish intervention block with small group focus (WIN)
  - What I Need Time
- Regular coaching meetings to focus on achievement and instructional conversations
- Data Teams and progress monitoring
- Continue to build teacher capacity with Teachers College, reading, writing and phonics work.

- Build a budget to support increasing diverse books in each elementary classroom
