

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER OF THE LEE COLLEGE BOARD OF REGENTS OF LEE COLLEGE, OF CHAMBERS AND HARRIS COUNTIES, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE 2025 APPRAISAL ROLL OF THE CHAMBERS AND HARRIS COUNTIES APPRAISAL DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, the Chambers and Harris Counties appraisal districts has submitted to the Lee College District, for approval, the 2025 tax appraisal rolls; and

WHEREAS, Board of Regents is of the opinion that the 2025 appraisal roll with the amounts shown therein should be adopted;

WHEREAS, the Chambers and Harris Appraisal Districts has certified to the Lee College District as of January 1, 2025, property with a total taxable value of \$21,809,604,148 and uncertified taxable value estimate of \$920,467,126.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS FOR THE LEE COLLEGE DISTRICT OF CHAMBERS AND HARRIS COUNTIES, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The 2025 tax appraisal roll, showing that there was situated in the Lee College District boundaries of both Chambers and Harris Counties, Texas, as of January 1, 2025, property with a total taxable value of \$21,640,402,218 and an uncertified taxable value estimate of \$920,467,126, as submitted by the Chambers and Harris Counties Appraisal Districts, is hereby adopted;

Section 2. The Board of Regents officially finds, determines, recites and declares that a sufficient written notice of the date, hours, place and subject of this meeting of the Board of Regents was posted at a place convenient to the public at the offices of the Lee College District for the time required by law preceding this meeting, as required by the Open Meetings Law, Texas Government Code; and that this meeting has been open to the public as required by law at all times during which this resolution and the subject matter thereof has been discussed, considered and formally acted upon. The Board of Regents further ratifies, approves and confirms such written notice and the contents and posting thereof.
