



# Balanced, Comprehensive, and Equitable Assessment System

- **Balanced** = There are many sources of data that inform our practices. We do not rely on a single measure.
- **Comprehensive** = We consider students' needs holistically, and target specific areas of need
- **Equitable** = We strive to meet the needs of each and every student by building on their strengths

# **Types of Assessment Data**

#### **Summative**

A standardized measure of year-end attainment of grade level standards

Example

MCA & ACCESS

#### Used To

Evaluate systems progress and comprehensive achievement

#### Screening

A universal measure of progress against grade-level norms and benchmarks

#### Example Fastbridge

**Used To** 

Guide MTSS and identify students who may need extra support

#### Diagnostic

An additional assessment done with some students when a risk factor is flagged in screening

#### Example

**Phonics Inventory** 

#### Used To

Determine a specific skill to address in a systematic way

#### Formative

Ongoing classroom evidence of student learning toward instructional goals

#### Example

Progress monitoring, tests, rubrics, projects


#### **Used To**

Plan instruction, provide feedback




## **Fastbridge Districtwide** aReading Winter 2022 - Winter 2025

(**Grades 1-9**) - a universal screening measure that is a useful estimate of broad reading achievement at 3 benchmarking periods per year over multiple grade levels. This is delivered completely online and adapts to the child's answer pattern to match the developmental and skill level of the student.








## **Fastbridge Districtwide** earlyReading Winter 2022 - Winter 2025

(**Grades PK-1**) - a measure for a broad indicator of overall reading achievement as well as component skills in 4 domains: concepts of print, phonemic awareness (sounds), phonics (sounds to letters), and decoding. These assessments are administered 1:1 with students.




