HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES

Homebound instruction is an educational service for students who have a need to be absent from school for an extended period of time for medical reasons.

To be eligible for homebound instruction a licensed physician needs to:

- 1. Indicate on the appropriate district form the diagnosis of injury, illness, or disorder, and other medical conditions; and
- 2. Specify the anticipated length of recovery time the student needs.

A maximum of five hours/week of licensed instruction will be provided (one hour/day average).
