Subject: Consider Approval of Space Act Agreement between CCISD and NASA for Reduced Gravity Flight for Hydroponics and Aeroponics Experiments				
Background:  Through the HUNCH (High School Students United with NASA to Create Hardware) program PLTW Engineering Design and Development students and their teachers, Alli Westover and Roger Elder, have developed equipment to conduct hydroponic growth experiments in space. This student-designed equipment could eventually be used on the International Space Station. As part of the evaluation process, NASA will conduct tests of the equipment in their reduced gravity aircraft. With the approval of this agreement both CSHS students and Mr. Elder will participate in the reduced gravity aircraft flights. In the past, Clear Creek High School HUNCH students and their teacher have participated in similar flights. This project is another example of the outstanding opportunities NASA provides for CCISD students.
