BOARD GOAL ADDRESSED: I. The Keller Independent School District shall

continually strive for academic excellence.

FISCAL NOTE: None

The AP (Advanced Placement) examinations are administered each year in May and represent the culmination of college-level work in a given discipline in a secondary school setting. Rigorously developed by committees of college and AP high school faculty, thirty-four AP Exams in nineteen subject areas nationwide are available to test students' ability to perform at a college level. Each test is scored on a 1-5 scale by College Board trained AP gradersWhile a score of 5 is the highest score possible, students may receive college credit for a score of 3 or better from participating universities nationwide. During the 2003-2004 school year Keller ISD administered 1024 AP tests in the twenty-three different areas listed below:

The chart below outlines the results of the 2003-2004 Keller ISD AP results. The first three columns indicate the number of tests administered and the percentage of those scoring 3 or better at each individual school as well as at the combined district results for the last three school years. The last three columns indicate the increase of tests administered on each campus, the increase in # of students scoring a 3 or better and the change in performance rate of scoring a 3 or better in one year's time. KISD had a total of 485 students who scored a 3 or better on the 2003-04 AP exams.
