Subject: Professional Development Agreement for September 27 Institute Day

Harlem School District has offered a Learning Fair for the entire certified staff for the past three years. The September 27th Learning Fair is designed to offer staff a variety of sessions to allow staff to choose sessions that most closely relate to their individual needs. Session topics are determined through staff surveys and school improvement plans. To plan for this, ISD worked with Harlem Personnel to fill in on topics they can support that align with school and district needs, and we are coordinating with the ROE to fill in on other areas identified through staff surveys and school improvement plans. The September 27th professional development will be a blend of professional development workshops offered by professionals recognized by the ROE and Harlem's PD Cadre, Administrators, and other Education Staff at Harlem. Through the Regional Office of Education, outside presenters will be scheduled to present on the proposed topics; the ROE will pay the professionals, and we will pay the ROE. 35 of the 42 presenters are being provided by internal presenters. The cost of outside presenters can be viewed in the table below:
