RECOMMENDATION:

The Texas Education Agency allows school districts the opportunity to offer a program that will offer flexible hours and days of attendance for students who:

- Has dropped out of school;
- A student is at risk of dropping out of school, as defined by the TEC, §29.081; or
- A student as a result of attendance requirements under the TEC, §25.092, will be denied credit for one or more classes in which the student has been enrolled.

In an effort to assist with the reduction of the dropout rate and increase student attendance rates at Lyndon B. Johnson and United South High Schools, administration proposes to continue to implement the PASS Program at Johnson High School and United South High School.
