<u>Discussion of Improvement Required (IR) Campus Updates</u>: Trustees received an update from the principals of the eight campuses under Improvement Required status. They each presented the current actions they are implementing towards improving teaching and student learning at each of their respective campuses. (The following campuses are on improvement required status under state accountability standards due to low state test scores: Blackshear, Downing, Goliad, Noel, Pease, and Zavala Elementary Schools, Bonham and Ector Middle Schools.)

<u>Discussion of Curriculum Audit Update</u>: Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum and Instruction Carolyn Gonzales and Director of Literacy Amy Harvey provided Trustees with recommendations in response to the November 8th WLK Educational Consultants curriculum audit presentation. The District will continue to work with WLK through this process. Below are highlights of the Districts response.

- Work has begun to create monthly pacing calendars.
- Work has begun on writing and vetting lesson plans for tested content and grades. Lessons will be aligned with the pacing calendar.

- Videos of teachers teaching different TEKS have been created and will be linked with the calendar/lesson plans.
- Teachers will be able to access the calendars and lesson plans within the Districts resources on TEKS Resource System.
- The calendars will include the TEKS and activities to support the TEKS.
- The units will each have their own folder with the necessary resources that a teacher would need to teach that unit.
- Training on how to access the documents will begin on January 9, 2018.
