Each Spring the school board approves a set number of transfers in from other school districts for the upcoming school year. This past year 53 slots were approved. I would like to recommend we close the remaining 9 open slots for this school year. We would still take students that meet transfer requirements for hardship as well as students that might move out of the district and want to stay with TRSD for the remainder of the year.

Each year at this time we look to our enrollment, space in classrooms and staffing. This year with the number of open positions we have and size of classrooms it would be advised we close the few openings we have. Currently we have opening on in Williams and Applegate School all other buildings are already closed.

This procedure follows the interdistrict transfer laws and policies and allows us as much flexibility to meet student/building needs as possible.
