6. Technology Plan Preview

Kevin Clark and Adam Hengel presented the timeline for the Technology Plan. The committee started goal setting in the Summer of 2023. They sent out a needs assessment and had staff create a wishlist. Goals are in four categories that align with the strategic plan pillars.

50% across all classrooms will have Newline Panels which is basically a 75 inch touch screen with a built in computer. The other 50% will be installed at a future date with 100% installed within the next two years.

They are looking to streamline technology support with easy set up and enhanced collaboration amongst teachers. The plan is to shift teachers to one device. Currently, educators have a Mac or a PC. We will eventually go to all Macs but this change will be phased in over several years.

Steve Carr gave the committee a condensed version of the Academic Career Plan that is now required by the state for Grades 6-12. All the details will be shared at an upcoming Board Workshop Meeting.
