6. Technology Plan Preview

*Kevin Clark and Adam Hengel presented the timeline for the Technology Plan. The committee started goal setting in the Summer of 2023. They sent out a needs assessment and had staff create a wishlist. Goals are in four categories that align with the strategic plan pillars.*

*50% across all classrooms will have Newline Panels which is basically a 75 inch touch screen with a built in computer. The other 50% will be installed at a future date with 100% installed within the next two years.*

*They are looking to streamline technology support with easy set up and enhanced collaboration amongst teachers. The plan is to shift teachers to one device. Currently, educators have a Mac or a PC. We will eventually go to all Macs but this change will be phased in over several years.*
