In November 2018, Gavin School District 37 was successful in passing a referendum that would add improvements to each of its two schools. The first phase of the project was completed during the 2019 summer break. Tonight, the Board is being asked to approve the 2020 summer projects as recommended by the Facility & Finance Committee members, Sherry Florian, Lenny Gahgan, and Jim Miller.

The referendum question as stated was:

“Shall the Board of Education School District Number 37, Lake County, Illinois, improve the sites of and alter, repair and equip school buildings, including by not limited to replacing roofs, improving secured entrances, updating science classrooms and improving HVAC systems, and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$6 million dollars for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?”
